AN ACT

To repeal certain acts relating to the erection of public buildings in the county of Fayette.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act entitled "An Act to authorize the erection of public buildings in the county of Fayette, and for other purposes, approved the twelfth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five;" and also the fourth section of an act entitled "A supplement to the act of Assembly, passed the twenty-ninth of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, relating to the proceedings in the orphans' courts of this commonwealth, and for other purposes, approved the fifteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five," which said section relates to the erection of the public buildings in the said county of Fayette, be and the same are hereby repealed; and that all the former laws of this commonwealth, or portions of laws repealed by the said act of the twelfth of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, be and the same are hereby revived.* Repeal of former acts. Certain acts revived.
