AN ACT

Creating an election district in Liberty township, Centre county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the qualified electors of the township of Liberty, in the county of Centre, *shall hold their general and township elections at the house now occupied by Christian Bechtol, in said township, and John Ligget and Hugh Shaw, are hereby appointed inspectors, and Samuel Bechtol, judge of the township election, to be holden at the usual time of holding township election in said county for the present year; and that the spring election of one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, and the spring elections, every year thereafter, shall be held on the third Friday in February.* Centre county, Liberty township.

AN ACT

Supplementary to an act, entitled "An Act to reduce the expenses in Berks and Washington counties."
