SUPPLEMENT

To an act passed the twelfth day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and thirty, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Fire insurance company of Northampton county."

WHEREAS, The members of the Fire insurance company of Northampton county, are desirous that the amount of their liability under their respective policies of insurance, should be limited and ascertained; and it is believed that it would be beneficial to the said company, so to limit and determine the same; therefore, Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, each and every member of the said Fire insurance company of Northampton county, shall be liable under the covenants in their respective policies of insurance for that purpose, in case of loss by fire, to pay to the said company for the use of the insured, a sum of money not exceeding three times the amount of the premium or deposit by such member deposited with, paid or secured to the said company; and the said member or members shall not be liable for any loss accruing at one and the same time, beyond tripple the amount of their premium or deposit as aforesaid: *Provided* Liabilities limited Proviso. *always,* That the premiums charged or deposits required by the said company, shall always be at such rate, that the whole amount for which the members shall be at all times liable, shall not be less than one hundred thousand dollars.
