A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Luthersburg and Punxatawney turnpike road company, and for other purposes," passed sixteenth day of April, Anno Domini eighteen hundred and thirty-eight.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president and managers of the Lancaster and Litiz turnpike road company, incorporated by the act to which this is a supplement, shall cause a road to be laid out forty feet wide, either from North Queen street, in the city of Lancaster, where the Harrisburg turnpike road meets the same, or from North Duke street, where James street crosses the same in the said city, to a point at or near the tavern now kept by Jacob Ziegler, in the village of Litiz, and at least twenty-one feet in breadth thereof; they shall make an artificial road to be made and constructed in manner as is particularly expressed in the tenth section of an act to enable the governor of this commonwealth to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the borough of Lancaster to the river Susquehanna, at or near Wright's ferry, passed April twenty-second, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-four; and the remaining part of the said road, they shall forever hereafter maintain and keep the same in good and perfect order and repair, for easy and convenient travelling, as a side or summer road during dry weather: *Provided*, That in any place where the said road cannot be laid out of the breadth of forty feet, without doing damage to the improvements on private property, they shall make such artificial road of the breadth of twenty-one feet, and the side or summer road of such breadth as such improvements will permit: *And provided further*, That discretionary power is given to the said board of managers, either to make or to assist to make a side or summer road along the slopes of the hill commonly called Kiessel hill.
