AN ACT

Authorizing the sale of the Sabbath school house in the borough of Lebanon.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That John Krause and John George, be and they are hereby authorized to sell and convey in fee simple, the Sabbath school house and lot of ground thereunto belonging, with the appurtenances situate in the borough of Lebanon, and held by trustees for the use and benefit of the Lutheran and German Reformed congregations of said borough: Provided, That before such sale shall take place, the said John Krause and John George, shall execute a bond with sufficient sureties, to be approved by the court of common pleas of Lebanon county, conditioned for the faithful application of the proceeds of such sale to the payment of the debts on said school house, and the remainder after the payment of said debts, to the said Lutheran and German Reformed congregations of the borough aforesaid.*
