

period of five years: *Provided*, That the supervisors, in their discretion, shall, from time to time, within said period of five years, widen the said roads, as the finances of the township will admit: *And provided also*, That this act shall not effect any suit or prosecution that shall have been or may be brought against the supervisors of said township, before the passage of this act, for not opening the roads within said township, according to existing laws.

AN ACT

Establishing the age at which children may be received into the common schools in the boroughs of Carlisle and Harrisburg.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That hereafter, the directors of the common schools in the boroughs of Carlisle and Harrisburg, shall not permit the teachers having charge of the several schools in said boroughs, to receive into said schools any child or children under the age of five years, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
