SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act relating to the liens of mechanics and others upon buildings."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the provisions of the act relating to mechanics' liens, passed the sixteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, with its supplements; and the fifth section of the act, entitled "An Act concerning certain sheriffs' and coroners' sales, and for other purposes," passed April sixteenth, eighteen hundred and forty-five, be and the same are hereby extended to Pike county. Relating to the Quincy school district, in the county of Franklin.
