AN ACT

To refund a certain amount of money paid by Henry Sively to the commonwealth.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That

the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay to Henry Sively, the sum of two hundred and seventy-eight dollars, and ninety-two cents, it being for moneys paid by said H. Sively, for a piece of land, the title to which was subsequently found not to be in the commonwealth; and also, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, for moneys expended by the said Henry Sively, in improvements made on the said lands; and the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to cancel all bonds in his possession, given by the said Henry Sively to the commonwealth, for the payment of the balance of the purchase money for said lands.
