AN ACT

Authorizing the commissioners of M'Kean county to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of making a certain road.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That

Commissioners to appropriate \$2000 for making road.

Expenditure.

Proviso.

a sum of money, to be drawn from the funds of said county, not exceeding in amount the sum of two thousand dollars, for the purpose of making a certain road leading from Smethport to the western line of the county of M'Kean, by the way of the Four Corners and Jonathan Marsh's; the expenditure on said road to be west of where Jonathan Marsh now resides, on the old state road route, with authority to make such alterations in the route as shall be necessary to shorten the distance and obtain the summit level from the Allegheny river, with the least ascent; and that the said money shall be expended on said road by and under the direction of the county commissioners of said county of M'Kean, within two years from and after the passage of this act: *Provided*, That no funds shall be expended for work done on said road, unless the same is done between the first day of May and the first day of September, in each of said two years as aforesaid.

One-fourth of road tax of Hamilton township to be paid to commissioners.

Proviso.

SECTION 2. That one-fourth of the road tax levied in the township of Hamilton, upon unseated lands shall, for the period of two years from the passage of this act, be paid to the county commissioners, to make up part of the two thousand dollars authorized to be expended by the first section of this act, for the purpose of making of this road, as specified in the first section: *Provided*, That the funds coming from Hamilton township, may be expended at any time after the two years from the passage of this act.
