AN ACT

To authorize the deputy surveyor of Venango county, to transcribe survey book of said county, and to require the surveyor general to make a draft of the donation lands in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the deputy surveyor of the county of Venango, is hereby authorized and required to copy into a suitable book, all the original surveys made by former deputy surveyors in said county, on warrants, improvements, and so forth, and that the said book, when certified to be a true copy of the original, to be received in evidence in all cases, in the same manner as the original book; and the commissioners of said county shall, out of the funds of the county, pay to the said deputy surveyor, a reasonable compensation, to be by them fixed, the same being first approved by the court.

SECTION 2. That the surveyor general is hereby required to make from the original surveys and general draft, a complete connected draft for the county of Venango, of so much of the several districts of donation land as lie within the said county, and certify the same under his hand and seal of office, and the same shall be received in evidence in all cases where the original surveys would be evidence: *Provided,* The county of Venango shall pay into the state treasury twenty-five dollars for the same.
