To annul the marriage contract of John De Puyster Douw, and Margaret Schuyler Douw.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between John De Peyster Douw, late of Albany, and now of the city of Philadelphia, and Margaret Schuyler Douw, late Margaret Schuyler Van Renssellaer, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from said contract, and from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely, as if they had never been joined in marriage.*
