AN ACT.

To authorize the president and directors of the Bank of Chambersburg, to reduce the capital of said bank.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That*

Capital reduced. the president and directors of the Bank of Chambersburg be and they are hereby authorized to reduce the capital of said bank, by twenty per cent. off the same, and to apportion said reduction among the shares and shareholders, pro rata, according to the amount actually paid in by each: *Provided*, That such reduction shall not be made until the same and this act are approved by a meeting of stockholders, to be called in the manner now provided for by law: *And provided*, That such reduction shall not be construed to alter, or in any way impair the individual liability of the stockholders of said bank, according to the terms and provisions of the act, entitled "An Act to extend the charter of the Bank of Chambersburg, and for other purposes," passed the eighth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act to incorporate "The Mine Hill and Schuylkill Haven railroad company," passed the twenty-fourth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That*

Increase of capital. to enable the Mine Hill and Schuylkill Haven railroad company to complete the extension of their road to the Swatara, and to accomplish the object of their incorporation, the capital stock of the said company may be increased in such manner, and at such times, as the board of mana-
