

from time to time, as may be necessary to pay the interest upon such loan or loans, and to redeem the principal at such times and in such manner as may be conformable to the terms upon which the same may be taken.

SECTION 2. The money borrowed under the provisions of this act, Appropriation. shall be appropriated to the erection of a court house, and offices to preserve the records of said county, in conformity with the recommendations and restrictions of the grand jury of said county, at October session, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five.

AN ACT

To authorize the auditor general to open and re-settle the account of William J. Wilson, late brigade inspector of the first brigade, fourteenth division, Pennsylvania militia.

SECTION I. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the auditor general, on sufficient cause being shown, is hereby authorized to open and re-settle the account of William J. Wilson, late brigade inspector of the first brigade, fourteenth division, Pennsylvania militia, and to allow said Wilson such credit or credits, as in law he is or may be entitled to, upon the presentation of proper and duly authenticated vouchers, verified by affidavit; but no credit shall be allowed on account of any sum erroneously paid to his successor.
