To authorize William Little, trustee of Mary Crossan, to reconvey certain property.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, By a certain indenture tripartite, executed by John M. D. Crossan, and Mary Little, both of the city of Pittsburgh, and William Little, late of the county of Allegheny, and state of Pennsylvania, but now of the county of Trumbull, and State of Ohio, bearing date the seventh day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, and recorded in the office for recording of deeds, &c., in and for the county of Allegheny, in deed book third, O, page four hundred and seventeen, the said Mary little, in contemplation of a marriage shortly to be had and solemnized between the said John M. D. Crossan and the said Mary, did convey unto the said William Little, in trust for the sole and separate use of her, the said Mary, all the estate of which she was seized under the will of John Little, late of the city of Pittsburgh, deceased, as recited in said deed of trust:

And whereas, The said Mary is desirous that the said William Little, trustee as aforesaid, should reconvey unto her the said Mary, all the estate recited in the above mentioned deed of trust, so that she may hold the same as fully and effectually as she did before said deed of trust was executed; therefore,

Authorized to reconvey.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That William Little, trustee of Mary Little, now Mary Crossan, be and he is hereby authorized to reconvey unto the said Mary Crossan, all the estate conveyed by the said Mary to the said William Little, in trust, by a certain indenture tripartite, executed by John M. D. Crossan, the said Mary, and the said William Little, bearing date the seventh day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, and recorded in the office for recording of deeds, &c., in and for the county of Allegheny, in deed book third, O, page four hundred and seventeen.
