A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act authorizing John Vanbilliard, and others, trustees, to sell and convey certain real estate."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the moneys raised by the sale of the school house and lot mentioned in the act to which this is a supplement, shall be paid as follows, to wit: Appropriation of two-thirds thereof to the erection or the indebtedness of the new brick school house, mentioned in the said act; and one third thereof to Joseph Clever, Simon Jones and Joseph Kemmerer, trustees of the Butztown school house, or their successors in said trust, for the purpose of discharging the balance due and unpaid on said building.

SECTION 2. That any misnomer of any of the persons authorized by the act to which this is a supplement, to sell the said lot and school house, shall not effect the title to the same in the hands of the purchaser.

Relating to streets and alleys in the borough of Saltsburg.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be lawful for the burgess and town council of the borough of Saltsburg, in the county of Indiana, to change the location of that part of Water street, in said borough, that is bounded on the east by lot number one hundred and eighty, in such a manner as will make the said street more convenient, and do as little injury to public and private property as possible; and it shall also be lawful for the burgess and town council aforesaid, to close up or
