SECTION 4. That the county treasurers are hereby required to perform Duty of county the duties enjoined on them, by the ninth section of the act which is treasurers. hereby altered, on or before the first day of November in each year, instead of the first day of October, as is provided in said section.

SECTION 5. That the provisions of the twentieth section of the act, ~~Repeal.~~ which is hereby altered, which apply to the first Monday in May, shall be deemed and taken hereafter, to apply to the first Monday in June, within the limits of the second brigade, ninth division, of the Pennsylvania militia.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, passed the twelfth day of April, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, entitled "An Act to authorize the governor to incorporate the Delaware county turnpike road company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the words "Thompson's hotel," contained in the tenth section of the Construction. act to which this is a supplement, shall be taken and construed to mean "Thompson's bridge," according to the true intent and meaning of said act.

SECTION 2. That when the said company shall commence operations When and by on said road, the townships through which the same may pass shall be whom license to relieved from repairing but three miles of said road from the eastern be granted to take termination thereof, instead of five miles, mentioned in said act; and toll. when the said three miles have been completed, the said company shall be authorized to erect a gate and collect tolls on said three miles, after having received a license therefor from the president judge of the court of quarter sessions of Delaware county, in the manner provided by the tenth section of the act to which this is a supplement; and it shall be the duty of said court, from time to time, to appoint proper persons to view any part of said road that may be completed, not less in extent than three miles in the first instance, and not less than two miles, upon any subsequent application made by the managers of said company.

SECTION 3. In making said road, the said company may be per- Alteration in mitted to allow the grade thereof to exceed the grade mentioned in grade.
