AN ACT

For the relief of Christopher Overly, Elizabeth Davidson, and others, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Christopher Overly, Elizabeth Davidson, of Westmoreland county, John Duff, of Armstrong county, Benjamin F. Corey, of Tioga county, John Sutherland, of Mercer county, Margaret Weir and James Oliver, of Indiana county, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars, or their respective orders, an annuity of forty dollars each during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six; and to their respective orders, and to the order of Abraham Brinker, of Butler county, the sum of forty dollars each, as a gratuity for services rendered during the Revolutionary and Indian wars.
