A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act authorizing Samuel Rockwell, junior, administrator of the estate of John C. Rose, late of Bradford county, deceased, to convey certain real estate, and for other purposes," passed the seventeenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as fixes or declares the consideration, or purchase money, of a certain piece or parcel of land, therein described, to be seventy-five dollars, be and the same is hereby repealed; and in lieu thereof, the sum of twenty-five dollars shall be deemed, and taken, as the consideration or purchase money of said piece or parcel of land; and the said act to which this is a supplement, shall hereafter be taken and considered as if the sum of twenty-five dollars had originally been inserted therein, as the consideration or purchase money of the certain piece or parcel of land therein described.
