AN ACT

Repealing an act, entitled "An Act prohibiting fishing, at certain seasons of the year, in certain creeks in the township of Marion, in the county of Berks," and to prevent fishing in certain streams in the county of Centre.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act, entitled "An act to prohibit fishing at certain seasons of the year, in certain creeks in Marion township, Berks county," passed the first day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Repeal of act prohibiting fishing in certain streams, in Berks county.

Fishing prevented in Spring creek, Centre county, in certain seasons.

SECTION 2. That from and after the passage of this act, it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to fish in Spring creek, or Logan's Branch of Spring creek, in Centre county, with seines or nets, at any and all seasons of the year; nor shall it be lawful to fish in either of said streams with hook and line, from the first day of August to the first day of April; and all person or persons offending against any or either of the provisions of this section, shall be subject to a payment of a fine not exceeding ten dollars, to be recoverable as debts of like amount are now by law recoverable; one half of such fine shall be paid to the informer, the other half to the supervisors of highways of the township of Spring, in the said county, to be by them applied in repairing the public roads of said township.
