A SUPPLEMENT.

To an act, passed the eleventh day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty, entitled "A supplement to the act relating to inspections."

county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, be and the same are hereby extended to the township of Northampton, in the county of Lehigh, and the jurisdiction of the inspector of domestic distilled spirits, for the borough of Allentown, in said county, for the time being, is hereby extended to said township.

AN ACT

Supplemental to the several acts of assembly incorporating the Wyoming academy, and the Wilkesbarre female seminary, and the Athens and Wysox academies.

Election for trustees of Wyoming academy, how conducted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the annual election of trustees of the Wyoming academy, provided for in an act of assembly, entitled "An Act granting certain powers to the authorities of the cities of Lancaster and Philadelphia, and for other purposes," approved the sixteenth day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, shall be held and conducted by the board of trustees for the time being, or such of them as may attend for this purpose at the time and place of election; and they shall determine all questions that may arise at the said elections; and so much of the tenth section of the aforesaid act of assembly, as requires the president and secretary of the said institution to conduct the said elections, and an assistant, to be chosen by the voters present, is hereby repealed; but the said elections, and those hereinafter provided, for the choice of

trustees of the Wilkesbarre female seminary, shall be conducted in accordance with the proviso of the said tenth section of the aforesaid act of assembly.

Wilkesbarre female seminary, how to be conducted.

SECTION 2. That it shall be lawful for the respective subscribers to the funds of the Wyoming academy and Wilkesbarre female seminary, who have paid, or shall hereafter pay their respective subscriptions, to designate the number of shares of stock in each corporation into which they wish their subscriptions to be divided, at five dollars a share; and said subscribers shall be entitled to receive from the said corporations respectively, certificates for as many shares of stock in each as their respective subscriptions and designations, as aforesaid, shall entitle them to receive, which certificates shall be transferrable, according to the rules and regulations relating thereto which may be adopted, or hereafter prescribed by the trustees of the said corporations respectively; and the secretaries of the said corporations shall keep a record of every certificate which the said corporations respectively may issue; and it shall be lawful for the loanholders of said corporations, with the consent of the trustees thereof, to convert their loans into stock in one or both of said corporations, in such proportions as they may designate, and to receive certificates of stock therefor in the manner aforesaid, at the rate of five dollars a share.

Privilege of subscribers to stock of said institution.

Certificates of stock transferable.

SECTION 3. On the first Monday of June next, and on the first Monday of every June thereafter, the aforesaid share or certificate-holders in the Wilkesbarre female seminary, may hold a meeting at any place in the borough of Wilkesbarre, to be previously designated by the trustees for the time being, notice whereof, and of the hour of meeting, shall be given by the secretary, in one or more newspapers printed in the said borough. At the said meetings, it shall be lawful for the said share-holders to elect by ballot nine trustees of said corporation, who shall hold their office one year from the date of their election, and until others shall be elected and qualified to supply their places, any five of whom shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business; and as often as any vacancy occurs in said board of trustees, they may fill the same by appointment of a new trustee to hold his office until the next annual election. The trustees for the time being, or such of their number as shall attend at the time and place of election, shall conduct the said elections, and determine all questions therein, and shall cause a record of said elections to be kept in the minutes of the corporation. The trustees who conduct the election of trustees of the Wyoming academy shall cause a like record of the said elections, to be kept in the minutes of their corporation.

Annual meetings and elections.

Vacancies, to be supplied.

SECTION 4. *Be it further enacted*, That the board of trustees of the Athens academy, in the county of Bradford, shall hereafter consist of seven members, four of whom shall be chosen annually by the qualified electors of the township of Athens, at their annual election for electing township officers, and the remaining three shall be chosen annually by the qualified electors of the borough of Athens, at their annual election for electing borough officers; and so much of any former act as is hereby altered or supplied, is hereby repealed.

Election for trustees of the Athens academy.

SECTION 5. *Be it further enacted*, That the trustees named in an act passed April eighth, one thousand eight hundred and forty, incorporating the Wysox academy, in the county of Bradford, or a majority of them, on due public notice, for ten days previous to the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, are hereby authorized to hold on that day, a meeting to elect trustees, according to the provisions of said act of April eighth, one thousand eight hundred and forty, which is

hereby revived ; and the authority of the trustees therein named, is hereby extended to the time of said election.

A N A C T
