A N A C T

To annul the marriage contract of James Waggoner, and Susanna his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between James Waggoner, and Susanna his wife, both of Fayette county, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, and effectually, and absolutely, as if they never had been joined in marriage.*
