AN ACT

To authorize the state treasurer to pay James and C. Rigby, a balance due on lock-house number two, on the Shenango line of the Pennsylvania canal.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay, on the warrant of the canal commissioners, to James and C. Rigby, or order, the sum of one hundred and eight dollars and twenty-nine cents, in full, for all the work done by them, under their contract, for constructing lock-house, at lock number two, of the Shenango line, Erie extension, Pennsylvania canal.*
