## AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract between Abraham C. Schanck and Amy, his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into between Abraham C. Schanck, of New Jersey, and Amy, his wife, late Amy Callender, of Bucks county, be and the same is hereby declared null and void, and the parties discharged from the obligations and liabilities growing out of the same, as fully and absolutely, as if they had never been joined in marriage.

## AN ACT

To authorize the trustees of the Evangelical Lutheran congregation, at Berlin, in the county of Somerset, to erect a school house.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Alexander H. Philson, Henry Fisher and Jacob Zorn, trustees of the Evangelical Lutheran congregation at Berlin, in the county of Somerset, and their successors in office, be and they are hereby authorized to apply so much of a certain bequest made by John Fletcher, late of said county of Somerset, deceased, to the Sunday school attached to the said congregation, as will be necessary for the erection of a school house, for the use of the said Sunday school: *Provided,* That the sum so applied shall not exceed eight hundred dollars.
