AN ACT

For the relief of Ephraim Jellison, Anne Hawk and others, soldiers and widows of
soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That*
the state treasurer be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay to
Ephraim Jellison, of Westmoreland county, Anne Hawk, of Armstrong
county, John Rehder, of York county, David George, of Allegheny
county, William Cannon, of Indiana county, John Stout, of Philadelphia
county, soldier and widow of soldier of the Revolutionary and Indian
wars, or their respective orders, an annuity of forty dollars each during
life, payable yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one
thousand eight hundred and forty-six; and to their respective orders,
and to the order of Margaret Dimm, of Lycoming county, the sum of
forty dollars each as a gratuity, for services rendered during the Revo-
lutionary and Indian wars.
