AN ACT

To authorize the brigade inspector of the third brigade, sixth division, Pennsylvania militia, to inspect the Washington Guards, a volunteer company, in Schuylkill and Northumberland counties, and to authorize the brigade inspector, third brigade, sixteenth division, Pennsylvania militia, to organize the Independent Washington Troop, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall be lawful for the brigade inspector of the third brigade, sixth division, Pennsylvania militia, to inspect the Washington Guards, a volunteer company, in Schuylkill and Northumberland counties, and attach said company to the third brigade, sixth division, Pennsylvania militia. Washington Guards to be inspected.

SECTION 2. That the brigade inspector of the third brigade, sixteenth division, Pennsylvania militia, be and he is hereby authorized to organize the Independent Washington Troop, of said brigade. Independent Washington Troop to be organized.

SECTION 3. That the Palmyra and Conewago companies, in Lebanon county, now attached to the third regiment, first brigade, sixth division, Pennsylvania militia, be and the same are hereby attached to the first regiment of said brigade and division; and that the field officers of the said first regiment be and they are hereby authorized to create an additional battalion, within the bounds of said regiment. Palmyra and Conewago companies attached to first regiment, first brigade, sixth division.

SECTION 4. That the Huntingdon and Union volunteer battalion, and the third battalion of the second regiment, second brigade, eighth division, in Luzerne county, be and the same are hereby formed into a regiment, to be called the Fifth regiment of the second brigade, eighth division; the volunteer battalion to be the first battalion, and the third battalion the second battalion. Fifth regiment, second brigade, eighth division, formed.
