In relation to the Bloomsburg railroad iron company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Bloomsburg railroad iron company of Bloomsburg, be and it is hereby authorized to subscribe to the stock of the Catawissa bridge company, in the county of Columbia, to an amount not exceeding one-sixth of the capital stock of the said Bloomsburg railroad iron company: *Provided,* That the stockholders of said company consent to the provisions of this act in writing.

A N A C T

To confer on Silas Evans, an illegitimate son of Elam Evans, of Chester county, the rights, privileges, benefits and advantages of a child born in lawful wedlock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Silas Evans, of Uwchlan township, in the county of Chester, an illegitimate son of Elam Evans, and of Margaret James, of the same township, shall have and enjoy all the rights, privileges, benefits and advantages of a legitimate child of the said Elam Evans, born in lawful wedlock; and shall be able and capable in law, to inherit and transmit any estate whatsoever, as fully and completely, to all intents and purposes,
