AN ACT

Supplementary to an act, entitled "An Act relating to collateral inheritances," passed seventh April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six.

Duty of assessors.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall be the duty of the assessors and assistant assessors of the several townships, boroughs, wards or districts within this commonwealth, whenever they shall be thereunto required by the commissioners, or register of the proper county, to proceed forthwith to make valuation and return of any property which may be designated to them as liable to the tax on collateral inheritances; and that they shall receive for their services, while so engaged, the same daily compensation as when engaged in the regular duties of their office, to be paid by the register, who shall be allowed credit therefor, in account with the state treasury.

AN ACT

Authorizing the court of common pleas of Cumberland county, to appoint auditors to audit the accounts of the borough of Carlisle, and for other purposes.

Court to appoint auditors to settle accounts of the borough of Carlisle.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the court of common pleas of Cumberland county, is hereby authorized and required to appoint three competent persons, residents of the borough of Carlisle, to audit the accounts of said borough for the last three years, who are hereby required to annually publish a statement of said accounts: *Provided,* That one of said persons shall be so appointed, for the term of three years, one for two years, and one for one year; and thereafter the said court shall annually appoint one person auditor, aforesaid.

SECTION 2. That the auditors appointed, as aforesaid, shall have Power of audit power to send for persons and papers, to compel the attendance of witnesses, and examine them upon oath, and shall receive from the treasury of said borough, as a compensation for their services, the sum of one dollar per day.

SECTION 3. That the court of general quarter sessions of the peace, Courts in Schuyl-kill county to continue the trial of causes in second week. and oyer and terminer, and general jail delivery of the county of Schuyl-kill, be authorized to continue the trial of issues, pending in said courts, during the second week of the term of the courts in said county, and that the proper venires be issued accordingly; and that the judges order the sheriff and commissioners to annex one and the same panel of names to the venire awarded by them, for the summoning of traverse jurors, returnable during that week.

SECTION 4. That the court of general quarter sessions of the peace, To appoint annually, trustees for Orwigsburg academy. of Schuylkill county, be and they are required, annually hereafter, at the December sessions, to appoint two trustees of the Orwigsburg academy, to serve for four years, in the room of those whose term of service is expired, to serve for four years; any law or laws which is hereby altered or supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act to incorporate a company for erecting a bridge over the river Susquehanna, at the town of Danville.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president, managers, and company, for erecting a bridge over the river Susquehanna, at the town of Danville, for the purpose of reconstructing said bridge, may increase the capital stock, in such manner and at such times as the president and managers may determine, to an amount not exceeding three thousand shares.

SECTION 2. And that it shall be lawful for the president and managers of the said company, to borrow, or to obtain on loans, such sums of money, and on such terms as they may deem expedient, for the use of said company, in the reconstruction of their bridge, not exceeding the sum of ten thousand dollars; and to issue certificates of loan therefor, in sums not less than one hundred dollars; and to pledge and mortgage
