AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract between Cornelius Hanes, and Sarah, his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into between Cornelius Hanes, of the county of Adams, and Sarah, his wife, be and the same is hereby declared null and void, and the parties discharged from all the obligations and liabilities growing out of the same, as fully and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled “An Act relating to the prison of the county of Chester,” approved the first day of February, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That any one of the inspectors of the prison of the county of Chester, may, Discharge of prisoners. out their sentence in said prison, as is given to the inspectors of said prison, by the second section of an act, entitled “A supplement to an act, entitled ‘An act relating to the prison of the county of Chester,’ approved February first, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, and relative to Dauphin county prison.”

SECTION 2. That each of the inspectors of said prison, shall be en- Compensation of titled to receive as compensation for his services, the sum of twenty-five inspectors.
