AN ACT

Supplementary to the acts relating to hawkers and pedlars, and regulating auctions in the county of Schuylkill.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* from and after the passage of this act, no person or persons shall sell, or expose to sale, within the county of Schuylkill, as a hawker, pedlar or traveling merchant, any foreign or domestic goods, wares or merchandize, under the penalty of fifty dollars for each and every offence, to be inflicted in the manner provided for in the act of April sixth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, entitled, "A supplement to the act regulating auctions in the city of Lancaster, and other towns of this commonwealth, passed the seventh day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-two."

SECTION 2. That sales at auction, in the boroughs, towns and villages of the county of Schuylkill, shall be regulated in the same manner as is provided in the act, entitled "An Act regulating auctions in the city of Lancaster, and other towns in this commonwealth," passed the seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, and the supplement thereto, passed the sixth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three; the auctioneers to be appointed in the same manner, paying the same duties, and liable to the same penalties and regulations mentioned in the said acts, which are hereby extended to the boroughs, towns and villages of the county of Schuylkill, and to the officers in the said county, and to the courts thereof, in the same manner as is provided for the officers and courts mentioned in the said acts: *Provided, That the provisions of this act shall not be so construed as to apply to persons carrying goods for wholesale purposes.*
