A N A C T

Authorizing the canal commissioners to examine the claim of J. M. Marshall.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the canal commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and required to examine the claim of J. M. Marshall, for damages alleged to have been done to a section boat, while passing over the Portage railroad, in one thousand eight hundred and forty-three; and if they shall clearly ascertain that said damages were occasioned by the negligence or misconduct of any state agents, they shall assess the same, and report the amount, together with the facts, to the legislature.*
