AN ACT

To confirm the title of the devisees of the reverend Richard Peters, deceased, to certain real estate in the city of Philadelphia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That the right and title of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in a certain lot of ground situated at the north-east corner of Schuylkill Second street, and High street, in the city of Philadelphia, is hereby released to the devisees of the reverend Richard Peters, deceased, the said lot having been conveyed by Jacob Mason, to the said Richard Peters, by deed dated the fifteenth December, one thousand seven hundred and fifty, under and subject to all arrears of taxes due upon the said lot.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act creating a *nisi prius* court, in the county of Philadelphia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the fourth section of the act, passed the twenty-sixth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Liberty fire engine company of Holmesburg, in the county of Philadelphia," as makes it the duty of one of the judges of the supreme court to hold a court of *nisi prius* in the city of Philadelphia, on the first Monday of September, in each year, be and the
