

SECTION 2. That from and after the first day of June next, the several Additional tax on prothonotaries of the supreme court shall, in addition to the tax now writs of error. imposed, also receive a further tax of one dollar on each writ of error thereafter issued, to be paid over to the reporter of the opinions and decisions of said court, to aid him in procuring for publication copies of said opinions ; but this section shall continue in force only until the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
