A N A C T

To extend the time for commencing and completing the Hamburg and Allentown railroad.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time of commencing the Hamburg and Allentown railroad, is hereby extended for the period of five years, from the thirty-first day of March, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six; and the time for completing the said road, to ten years from and after the said date.*

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An Act authorizing the governor to incorporate the Bear Mountain railroad company, and for other purposes," passed thirteenth of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time for the completion of the Bear Mountain railroad, be and the Time for completion is hereby extended for the term of five years; and the said Bear Mountain railroad company are hereby authorized, under the terms and conditions of their act of incorporation, to connect their said road with the road of any other company; in such manner, however, as to do no injury to the track of such road.*
