AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of John Feller and Eliza, his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between John Feller and Eliza, his wife, both of the county of Lancaster, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from said contract, and from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely, as if they never had been joined in marriage.*

AN ACT

To extend the charter of the Bank of Commerce.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the charter of the Bank of Commerce shall be, and the same is hereby extended and continued, for the period of ten years, from the expiration of its present charter, subject to all and singular the same provisions and restrictions, as are imposed on the Western Bank of Philadelphia, by the act, entitled "An Act to extend the charter of the Western Bank of Philadelphia," approved the seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six; and the stockholders of the said Bank of Commerce, shall be subject to the same liabilities and*
