AN ACT

To extend the time for completing the Bald Eagle and Spring Creek navigation.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the time for completing the Bald Eagle and Spring Creek navigation company, mentioned in the twenty-fourth section of the act of the fourteenth of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, and the fourth section of the act of the twenty-eighth April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty, be and the same is hereby extended for a further period of five years.

AN ACT

Authorizing the construction of an out-let lock on the Delaware division of the Pennsylvania canal.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the canal commissioners are hereby authorized and required to construct an out-let lock, at least one hundred feet long, by twenty-two feet wide, from the head of the level of the feeder, to the Delaware division at Wells' falls, and to complete the connection between the said feeder level and the river Delaware; and to defray the expenses of the construction of said out-let lock and fixtures, and to pay such damages as may be assessed, as herein directed, the said commissioners are hereby authorized to borrow such sum as may be necessary for that purpose, not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not higher than five per cent. per annum, payable half yearly, if such loan can be had on the terms, and in view of the means of the payment of the principal and interest thereof, as hereinafter directed.
