AN ACT

Fixing the time for the adoption and publication of tolls on public works.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passage of this act, the canal commissioners shall, and they are hereby required to adopt, fix, declare and publish the rates of toll on the public works of this commonwealth, for the then next ensuing twelve months, or the residue of the year, on or before the first day of January, in each succeeding year hereafter.*
