A N A C T

Supplementary to an act, entitled "An Act authorizing the governor to incorporate the Washington and Pittsburg railroad company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act to which this is a supplement, be and the same is hereby revived, and that Thomas M. T. M'Kenna, Colin M. Reed, John N. Dagg, James Brice, John Wishart, John H. Ewing, Thomas Watson, Benjamin Anderson, John Bower, James M'Closkey, Jacob Morgan, James Ruple, John Parke, Wallace M'Williams, N. Beady, William Creacraft, William Colshan and Thomas Ringland, of Washington county; John Gelfillan, William Espy, William Lea, James Glenn, J. P. Ross, John F. Murray, Thomas Blackamore, Frederick Lavery, Alexander Carnahan, Joseph E. M'Cabe, John Anderson and John Wrenshall, of the county of Allegheny, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, to do and perform the several duties devolved on the commissioners by the act above recited, and that they be required to open the books for the subscription of stock, on or before the first day of December next. Commissioners.

SECTION 2. That the provisions of the twenty-second section of the act to which this is a supplement, are hereby renewed and continued, according to the terms of the said section, from the date of this act. Part of act revived.

SECTION 3. That if it shall appear that the privileges granted by this act, are injurious to the interests of this commonwealth, the legislature reserve the right to revoke, alter or annul the charter hereby granted, at any time they may think proper: *Provided*, That no injustice be done to the corporators: *And provided further*, That the state may at any time after the expiration of thirty years, have the privilege of purchasing the entire interest and property of the said corporation, at a fair and reasonable valuation or appraisement, to be made in such a manner as may, at any time hereafter, be provided for by law: *And provided further*, That any part of the twenty-fourth section of the act to which this is a supplement, as is hereby altered or supplied, is hereby repealed.
