AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract between Andrew Ney and Elizabeth, his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between Andrew Ney, of the county of Wyoming, and Elizabeth, his wife, be and the same is hereby declared null and void, and the parties discharged from all the obligations and liabilities growing out of the same, as fully and absolutely, as if they had never been joined in marriage.*

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between Nicholas Carpenter and Harriet his wife, the latter a resident of the county of Luzerne, and that of the former not known, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, and effectually, and absolutely, as if they never had been joined in marriage.*
