AN ACT

Changing the name of Mary Schaper, to that of Mary Simmons.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Mary Schaper, of Philadelphia, shall henceforth be called and known by the name of Mary Simmons, and by that name, be capable of suing and being sued, and of granting and taking any real or personal estate, by grant, devise or purchase, in the same manner, as if she had been baptized, and always known by the name of Mary Simmons.*

AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract between Nelly West and Henry West, her husband.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between Nelly West, and Henry West, her husband, of the county of Bradford, be and the same is hereby declared null and void, and the parties discharged from all the obligations and liabilities growing out of the same, as fully, and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.*
