Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That our senators and representatives in congress be and they are hereby requested to use all honorable means to secure the location of the said naval depot at Erie, in the state of Pennsylvania.

Resolved, That the governor be requested to transmit copies of the above preamble and resolutions, to the president of the United States, the several heads of departments, and each of our senators and representatives in congress.

RESOLUTION

Relative to the Allegheny county mutual insurance company.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That the failure on the part of the Allegheny county mutual insurance company, to elect a board of directors on the day appointed for the last annual election, in conformity with the provisions of the act of incorporation and the by-laws of the said company, shall not be construed to work any suspension of the corporate franchises, or in any way to impair, alter, or affect the rights or obligations of the said corporation or of any of the members thereof, and that the last previous board of directors shall continue in office until the period fixed by the by-laws for the next annual election, and until their place shall be regularly supplied by a new election.
