AN ACT

Entitled "An Act changing the time for holding the borough elections in Wellsborough, Tioga county."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the borough elections in Wellsborough, Tioga county, shall hereafter be held on the Friday preceding the third Monday of February in each year; and the returns of the same shall be made to the court of quarter sessions for said county, on the first day of the term succeeding said election.

AN ACT

To change the name of Henry Carson Grubb.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Henry Carson Grubb, of the city of Philadelphia, son of the late Henry Bates Grubb, be and is hereby authorized to change his name from Henry Carson Grubb, to that of Henry Grubb Carson; and he shall henceforth be called and known by the name of Henry Grubb Carson, and by that name he shall be able and capable in law, to sue and be sued, grant, receive and inherit property, and to do all other legal acts and things as fully and effectually, to all intents and purposes, as he could have done under his former name if no change had been made therein.
