AN ACT

Authorizing the administrators de bonis non of James Loughhead, late of the county of Columbia, deceased, to sell and convey certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* Alexander Best and William Forsyth, administrators de bonis non cum testamento annexo of James Loughhead, late of Danville and county of Columbia, deceased, and the survivors of them, be and are hereby authorized from time to time, as occasion shall require, to sell at public or private sale, by parcels or otherwise, as may be most convenient, all the lands and real estate of which the said James Loughhead died seized or possessed, situate in the county of Columbia aforesaid; and to apply the proceeds of such sale or sales, after deducting the expenses of sale, and the commissions which shall be allowed to them for their services, by the orphans' court of the said county of Columbia, to the payment of the legacies and bequests made and bequeathed by said testator; and the said Alexander Best and William Forsyth or the survivors of them, are further authorized to make and execute a deed or deeds, for the said lands and real estate, to the purchaser or purchasers, all the title and interest which the said James Loughhead had and held in the same, at and immediately before the time of his death: *Provided, That* the said Alexander Best and William Forsyth shall give bond to the commonwealth in such form, in such sum and with such sufficient surety or sureties, as the orphans' court of the said county of Columbia shall direct and approve, conditioned for the faithful execution of the trust hereby committed to them, and for due and proper application of the proceeds of said sale or sales: *And provided also, That* before any such sale shall be valid, it shall be approved by the said orphans' court.
