## AN ACT

To authorize the trustees of the German Lutheran and German Reformed congregations of Pine Hill meeting house, in Brothers' Valley township, Somerset county, to sell and convey certain real estate, and to apply the proceeds in building a new union house of worship.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* George Walker, trustee of the German Lutheran, and George Hay, trustee of the German Reformed congregation of Pine Hill meeting house, in Brothers' Valley township, Somerset county, or their successors in office, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell, by public vendue, and convey the same by deed of conveyance, in fee simple, to the purchaser thereof, about twenty acres more or less, of a certain tract of land, situate in Brothers' Valley township, Somerset county, and patented to them on the seventh day of February, eighteen hundred and eighteen, in trust for the aforesaid congregations, adjoining lands of Nicholas Coleman, Nicholas Shultz, Michael Beechley and others, containing twenty-three acres and one hundred and forty-nine perches and allowance; and to apply the proceeds of said sale to the erection of a new union house of worship, for the use of the aforesaid congregations, on the remainder of said tract of land: *Provided always,* That the proceeds of the said sale be appropriated exclusively to the erection of a new union house of worship, for the use of the aforesaid congregations, under the direction of the church wardens of said congregations.
