AN ACT

To authorize the commissioners of Westmoreland county, to appoint an assessor for North Huntingdon township.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of Westmoreland county, be and the same are hereby authorized and directed to appoint a competent person to act as an assessor for the present year, for North Huntingdon township, in the said county, and issue their precept to such assessor so appointed, who shall thereupon, proceed to assess all the property in said township subject to taxation, in the manner as is prescribed by existing laws; the return of the said assessor shall be acted upon in all respects, as if the same had been made by the regular assessor at the regular time of making such returns.

AN ACT

Changing the time of holding township elections in Tionesta township, Venango county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the ensuing township election in Tionesta township, Venango county, shall be held on the third Friday of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty seven, and annually thereafter on the second Friday of February, in every year, to be conducted in accordance with existing laws regulating township elections.
