AN ACT

Authorizing William Guthrie of Westmoreland county, to construct a wing dam in the Kiskiminetas river.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* William Guthrie of Westmoreland county, be and is hereby authorized to erect a wing dam not exceeding three feet in height, in the Kiskiminetas river, at or near the town of Warren, in Armstrong county, in such manner as shall do no damage to either public or private property.

AN ACT

Relating to the York and Maryland line turnpike company.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, By indenture dated the ninth day of October, on thousand eight hundred and forty-six, and recorded in the office for recording deeds, in and for the county of York, in book TTT. at pages six hundred and two, six hundred and three, the York and Maryland line turnpike company did cede and convey, for the considerations therein mentioned, all that part of their said turnpike road lying and being within the limits of the borough of York, to the burgesses and inhabitants of the said borough ; therefore,

Title made valid.

Company discharged from the duty of repairing the road.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the said indenture be and is hereby declared to be valid and effectual, to all intents and purposes, to transfer so much of the said turnpike road to the burgesses and inhabitants of the borough of York, as is in said indenture mentioned; and that the York and Maryland line turnpike company, be and is hereby discharged from the obligation to keep that part of their road in repair, and from all liability to answer in damages,
