AN ACT

Relating to roads in certain townships in Luzerne county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the sixth section of an act, entitled "A supplement to an act, entitled 'An Act relating to roads, highways and bridges in the counties of Warren, Venango and M'Kean, and for other purposes,' approved thirtieth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six," be and the same is hereby repealed.*

SECTION 2. *That all and every of the acts done and performed, and to be done and performed by the supervisors elected at the last township elections, in the several townships enumerated in the said sixth section as above repealed, be and the same are hereby made legal, and of as binding effect as if the said act had never been passed.*

AN ACT

To repeal an act relative to certain courts.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the first section of an act relative to certain courts, passed the twentieth day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-six, be and the same is hereby repealed: Provided, That the February terms of the several courts for the present year, shall be held in the same manner and at the*
