

and eight, granted and conveyed to Robert Coleman in fee : *Provided, Proviso.* That no sale shall be made by her until she shall have given such security as the orphans' court of Lancaster county shall direct, for the faithful execution of the power committed to her, and for the due application, according to law, of the proceeds of such sale or sales.

AN ACT

Relating to road damages in Colebrookdale township, Berks county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the second section of the act, entitled “An Act relating to views of roads and damages in the counties of Monroe and Montgomery, and for other purposes,” approved the seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, be and the same is hereby repealed.
