A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the village of Bethlehem, in the county of Northampton, into a borough."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the burgess and council of the borough of Bethlehem, in the county of Northampton, are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow, on the faith and credit of the said borough, any sum or sums not exceeding, in the whole, an amount of fifteen hundred dollars, for the purpose of grading and improving the streets, roads, lanes and alleys of said borough; and they are further authorized and empowered to appropriate the one-third part of the borough tax of each and every year, (commencing with the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven,) to the repayment of the principal and interest of said loan, until the same is fully paid.
