A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Little Schuylkill navigation, railroad and coal company."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the time fixed by law for extending and completing the railroad of the Little Schuylkill navigation, railroad and coal company, be and the same is hereby extended for the period of five years, from and after the passage of this act, or until the period at which the Luzerne and Schuylkill railroad company, and the Little Schuylkill and Susquehanna railroad company, or either of them, shall be prepared to connect therewith; and the said company is hereby authorized to charge and receive a rate of tolls, not exceeding one and a half cents per ton per mile on coal or other mineral, and two cents per ton per mile on merchandize and other commodities, passing over their road; and that the act, entitled "A supplement to an act incorporating the Little Schuylkill navigation, railroad and coal company," passed the seventh day of April, Anno Domini eighteen hundred and forty-six, be and the same is hereby repealed: *Provided,* That in times of war, invasion or domestic insurrection, the said company shall carry and transport, or permit to be carried and transported on said railroad, any troops called into service by any competent authority, their ordnance, munitions and military stores, at one-half the usual charge, for the time being, for carrying and transporting other passengers and freight.
