AN ACT

Relative to the Dingman's Choice turnpike road company, in the county of Pike.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* John Westbrook, president, Martin W. Dingman, William F. Brohead, John Layton, William Layton, William Dusenbury and Joseph Flemming, managers of the Dingman's Choice turnpike road company, or their successors in office, are hereby authorized to erect a gate, for the collection of tolls, on the first five miles of said road that may be made and completed according to law.
